## Umpire Training



### Field Training

Field training is done outside on the baseball field. On the field we cover mechanics, footwork, and positioning. We go through drills to help build muscle memory so that you look crisp and confident on the field.

For all of the field clinics, you will participate in drills. Wear athletic clothing. Bring a baseball glove and umpire gear, if you have it.
